- I. Jesus is subject to rejection (1–3)
 - A. He invades the sphere of unbelief (1–2a)
 - B. He encounters the folly of unbelief (2b)
 - C. He withstands the hatred of unbelief (3)
- II. Jesus is responsive to rejection (4–6)
 - A. He discerns the nature of unbelief (4)
 - B. He accepts the limits of unbelief (5)
 - C. He ignores the deterrent of unbelief (6)
