# **PROVIDENCE PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH**

#### REFLECTION

"Jesus describes himself as the one who 'lays down His life for the sheep' (John 10:11). While the work of the shepherd could be dangerous at times in warding off wild animals, giving up his life must have been a fairly rare occurrence among Palestinian shepherds. Ordinarily, the shepherd's calling was not to die for the sheep but to live for the sheep. Jesus' charge was unique, however, as he came to provide protection from the ultimate eschatological danger of condemnation for sin through giving his life as the substitutionary atonement for the transgressions of his flock. He laid down his life and was able to 'take it up again' (John 10:18), his resurrection from the dead being the exclamation point on his finished work on behalf of the sheep. The comprehensiveness of his care extends through eternity and, therefore, his sheep are absolutely secure."
