What do people put on *Craigslist*?

Things that aren't valuable anymore? Stuff they don't care about...?

Craigslist.... Pastor Craig's got a list! You could call it "Craig's list!" ©

But it's not a for-sale list... "Craig's list" is a prayer list!

Everyone in this room is on my list!

But a few of you are in a special section!

I'm praying for you all the time, some of you for years....

I'm asking God to save you, to pour His mercy & grace on your mind & heart.

So I've been telling you the Gospel this month & I've been reviewing my list almost every day!

So don't you even *think* about dying before I finish telling you these *six* truths (*final* 2 this morning)!

Here's where we've been, so far...

- 1. God owns you.
- 2. You disowned God.
- 3. God judges sinners.
- 4. Jesus died for sinners.

This morning...

- 5. Jesus lives again.
- 6. You must choose...be careful how you choose.

Let's *quickly catch up* on those *first* **four** truths:

Here is the *first fact* that everyone needs to hear about God: *God made you*. He made you *personally*. He made you in His *own image*. Because He *made* you, He *owns* you. Because He *owns* you, you are *accountable* to Him.

Next truth: You disowned God. God is your Creator-King, but you are a willful rebel. You break His laws. You make your own rules. You pretend He doesn't care or doesn't even exist. You're a rebel – a sinner.

Third: God *judges* sinners. The penalty for sinful rebellion is *death* followed by *judgment*. Someone must be *punished* for sin – or God is not really *just & holy*. **Does** *this* **sound like good news...!?!** Don't give up yet...

Fourth fact. Jesus died for sinners! Here comes the good news – someone must be punished for your sins – but it doesn't have to be you! God sent His own perfect & sinless Son, Jesus the God-man, to die in the place of sinners. Jesus died as a substitute payment: God made Christ who knew no sin to be sin on our behalf...

Jesus died, but that's not the end of the story!

Because the crucified Savior was buried, but raised to life on the 3rd day!

Angel (Garden tomb early on the 3rd day): "Why do you seek the Living One among the dead, He is not here, but He has risen, just as He said!"

Jesus is *alive* right now.

This isn't some old *Sunday School story* that you can *dismiss* w/ a *nod* & *smile*, & then hastily *move on*.

It's time to choose! You must come to grips w/ God's only offer: to follow His Son Jesus as your Lord & Savior...or to continue under the certain threat of God's wrath.

Jesus is *alive*!

- 1. But how do you **know** this *Gospel* story is *for real*? What if Jesus just died this *tragic martyr's death*, but it didn't really *do* anything?
 - a. **Let's read** a crucial text on the non-negotiable necessity of a *real* historic *resurrection:* **1 Cor 15:17-22.** The Corinthians were troubled by a very *basic question*: is the resurrection of the dead *true*?
 - b. Let's look *hard* at **v.17.** Paul makes his point in the *negative*, and it's very clear: *if Jesus has not been raised, your faith is worthless.*
 - i. Your faith is *worthless...why?* How is *faith* in Christ's *death* also tied this incredible claim of His *resurrection*?
 - ii. Because...if Jesus has not been raised...you are still in your sins! Jesus' crucifixion paid for nothing.
 - c. Here is Paul's *point*: The Resurrection is about *proof*. Jesus *died* on the cross *in your place* to *pay for your sins*. The *proof* that God *accepted* Christ's payment is that God *raised His Son from the grave!* That's how you know! The resurrection **proves** the *atoning power of the cross*!
 - d. Paul goes on to *draw* a very *startling conclusion* (**19**): if you only believe the *crucifixion* **w/o** believing the *resurrection* you're *pitiful!* You are *wasting* your time; you should have stayed *home* & stayed in *bed!*
 - e. But it's all *real* (**read vv. 20-22**)! You *aren't* pitiful. The resurrection *is* true. Christ *lives* He is alive *right now*. As sure as you are *here* He is *there*! His resurrection *proves* His payment *really pays*.
 - i. And just as every son & daughter of Adam are lost in their sins,
 - ii. ...even so, every *woman & man* who *turns to Christ* trusting in His *death &* His *resurrection* is *forgiven*, & will *live*.
 - f. That resurrection *proves* that God accepted Jesus' *death for sinners*.

- 2. The Bible says *even more* about the *reality* & the *results* of the *resurrection*. Here are **five** *truths* the Gospel teaches about Jesus' *resurrection*:
 - a. First, the resurrection is an essential part of the Gospel message. Paul distills the Good News message down to these 4 basic truths: For I delivered to you as of 1st importance that which I also received, that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, that He was buried, that He was raised on the 3rd day according to the Scriptures, and that He appeared to many. The resurr is essential to the Gospel.
 - b. *Second*, the resurrection proves God has *accepted* Jesus' *payment* in your *place*. Which *then* means that Jesus has *conquered* the power of *sin*. We just examined that in **1 Cor 15:17f**.
 - c. Third, the resurrection certifies that Jesus is God's Son. Rm.1:4 − Christ Jesus...was declared the Son of God w/power by the resurrection from the dead. → Because Jesus is God's Son, He was qualified to die for sinners.
 - d. Fourth, we also saw (1 Cor 15:22) that Christ's resurrection assures your future resurrection. Jesus has conquered the power of death. When a Christian dies, his spirit lives w/Christ forever, & his body will someday be raised & glorified, just like the Lord's.
 - e. Fifth, the risen Savior lives to keep you, & to pray for you. **Hb 7:25** [Therefore He is able also to save forever those who draw near to God thru Him, since He always lives to make intercession for them.]

- **3.** Jesus is alive! You sit there. He is seated there (right now) at the right hand of His Father.
 - **a.** This is *non-negotiable*. You *must believe* that Jesus *died* to pay for your *sins* & you *must* also believe God *raised* Him from the grave.
 - **b.** If the resurrection *isn't* true, you have *no proof* that God has *accepted* the death of Jesus *in your place*, for *your sins*. You have no *verification* of the promise of *eternal life*.

But, ... I stand before you this day, declaring to all men &women, young & old, Christ has been raised! ©

Which means you have to make a choice ...

- 1. It's the most *critical*, life-changing *choice* you will ever be confronted with. More important than what you do after *graduation*...than how you'll be *employed*...where you'll *live*...even more important who you will *marry*!
 - a. Listen while Jesus spells out your choice for you (Jn 3:36): ["He who believes in the Son has eternal life; but he who does not obey the Son will not see life, but the wrath of God abides on him."] 2X
 - i. Do you **understand** your *choice*...? To *believe* in Christ, or to *disobey* (spurn, refuse, or simply to *ignore*) His offer.
 - ii. Do you **understand** what's at stake: *eternal life* or *eternal wrath*!
 - b. Why do people refuse? (Why would you refuse Christ!?!)
 - i. **Rich Young Ruler**? Excited! Stops Jesus. "Good teacher, what must I do to inherit eternal life?" Commandments? "All these things I have kept..." One thing you lack, go & sell all; come& follow Me. He went away sorrowing, for he possessed... He tripped on the 10thcom.; he didn't want give up what he had. Is there something you don't want to give up...?
 - ii. Perhaps you *refuse* because you don't really *understand* the *seriousness* of the Gospel (**e.g.** you don't see how *sinful* God says you are). Or, maybe you just *won't* believe the Gospel.
 - iii. Maybe you're too *proud* to admit your sin; maybe too *proud* to *turn* from your old ways & *follow* Him. "What would my *friends/family say...?*"
 - iv. Maybe you simply love your *sin*! Maybe you won't *abandon* your *false gods* (success, relationship, *pleasure*).
 - v. If you are about to reject Jesus, can I give you some advice? **Beg** God for **faith** ... beg Him for a **repenting heart**.

- 2. Here's what *I've* been praying, young friend that you *want* to trust Christ!
 - a. The **NT** tells a story about *Paul & Silas* being beaten & thrown in *jail* for preaching Christ in *Philippi*. They spent the night *praying & singing*, & at midnight an enormous *earthquake* rocked the *jail &* freed all the *prisoners*. The terrified *jailer* rushes in & cries out to Paul & Silas, "Sirs, what **must I do** to be saved?" **2x**
 - b. Are you ready for the *answer*? ... It doesn't have a thing to do w/baptism or good works or self-reform or church membership! It has everything to do w/faith! Paul & Silas said, "Believe in the Lord Jesus, & you will be saved..." > (spoke the word of the Lord to him)
 - c. That's it: if you want to be delivered from God's wrath & gain eternal life, you need to believe the Bible's story about Jesus (6 truths). Turn w/ me to Rm 10:9-10.
 - i. Look at **v.9** *carefully*. Its promise is *simple*, but *profound*. *Salvation* is granted to the young *man or woman* who...
 - 1. *Confesses Jesus as Lord*. **Two** huge ideas in these **four** small words: a.) *Confess*... a *sincere public agreement* that Jesus is Lord. b.) Jesus is *Lord*. You are agreeing to *follow Him* as *Master & Savior* for the rest of your life.
 - 2. **Believe** in your heart God raised Him from the dead. The Bible's concept of the heart is much stronger than ours; it means your mind & emotions & will all that you are on the inside. Which tells you that real faith is way more than a mere mental nod to a Sunday School story or a list of Bible facts!
 - 3. *Faith* says that Jesus is *exactly* who the Bible says He is, and that you will *turn & follow* Him as *faithfully* as you can, from *now on*.
 - ii. The Bible goes on to explain (**10**) that *believing* w/ *all* that you are (*heart*), and agreeing to *follow* Jesus as your *Lord*, will bring your *salvation* Christ will *rescue* you from your *sins*!

- iii. But I now need, again, to be very *clear* that Jesus taught a very *strong* definition of *faith*. Turn w/me to **Mk 8:34-35.**
 - 1. First, I want to point out that when it comes to responding to Jesus, the Bible joins **two** related truths: faith & repentance. **Both** trust & turning are in Jesus'call.
 - 2. Here, repentance & faith are blended together; here is the only flavor of faith that will save you, beloved: deny yourself (Rich Young Ruler, sell all!), pick up your cross (die!), follow Jesus.
- d. What happens when you *turn & confess & believe*, like this? What happens when you *believe* Jesus & Jesus *saves* you?
 - i. Complete *forgiveness* of all your sins; *past, present, & future!* (Because of Jesus' *payment* on the cross).
 - ii. God's righteousness accounted to you (also Jesus' payment).
 - iii. God's Holy Spirit comes in to live in you, forever.
 - iv. You're born again; receive new life (new heart) → eternal life!
 - v. Adoption into God's family. You are His daughter/son.
 - vi. Citizenship in Christ's kingdom. → Jesus is your Lord... King!
- e. "Tell me one more time, Craig, what must I do to be saved?"
 - i. First, you have to *understand* & accept the Gospel as true.
 - ii. *Trust* that *Jesus*' death & resurrection are *enough* (no works added!) & that His death was *for* **you** *for* **your** *sins*.
 - iii. Count the cost. He is demanding to be your lifelong Lord.
 - iv. *Turn* from your old life and *follow after Him*.
 - v. God isn't asking for an event or a ritual walking an aisle, praying a prescribed prayer, being baptized (later...). Right now all He wants is your life-changing, all that you are, repentance & faith!

I want to leave you w/ a promise. Not my promise $\bigcirc -Jesus$ 'no-fail promise!

- 1. **Join me in Jn 6:37.** Jesus promises that, whoever comes to Him will not be turned away! No one never.
- 2. Now re-examine the *first half* of Jesus' words. God's children *will come* to Christ! You want to be *God's child*, don' you? You need to *go to Him*!
- 3. And then there's the rest... "the one who comes to Me I will certainly not cast out!" 2x If you come, He accepts you!
- 4. Here is what I ask of almost everyone I share this promise with (my own children): Read this Gospel promise (6:37). Grab hold of this promise!

 Pray this promise until Christ answers & you know in your heart for certain that you've trusted Him, you've come to Him, & He's saved you!

...pray... faith & repentance. Father, assure them they are Yours!

Response:

Believers. You've heard the Good News again this month. Can I press on you what Paul pressed on the Corinthians: *Test yourself to see if you are in the faith - examine yourself!* I hope that Christ will *assure* you that *you are His!*

Pray for those around you who need Christ. Ask them where they are with all this!

W/o Christ? You are making a choice right now! To refuse to choose is to make a choice – and you aren't guaranteed another opportunity. Don't delay! Believe in the Lord Jesus. Take Jesus' promises to God & beg to be saved. He will answer.
