- (2) Convicting the World In <u>Three Aspects</u> 22
 - "of sin, because they do not believe in Me"
 - It is the Spirit who convinces men of sin

-1- Convicting the World of Sin

The primary demonstration of the world's sin is seen in their rejection of Jesus Christ - their refusal to believe in Him.

- At issue is Jesus Christ and His claims.
- -2- Convicting the World of Righteousness "of righteousness, because I go to the Father and you see Me no more"
 - It is the Spirit who convinces men of righteousness:

Their own utter lack of righteousness The *perfect* righteousness of Jesus Christ.

- -3- Convicting the World of Judgment "of judgment, because the ruler of this world has been judged."
 - It is the Holy Spirit who convinces men of judgment.

The sure judgment which is to come. Because in Jesus' death Satan has been judged; the present evil age is passing away.

Further Application:

- 1. These are the fundamental elements of gospel preaching!
- 2. The Holy Spirit demonstrates the same in every child of God:
 - Trust in Christ alone
 - Trust in the righteousness of Christ alone
 - A life in which sin has been and is being judged
