Examine the Scriptures (Be Berean!)

- John's theme of Jewish unbelief: John 1:11
- Three National Feasts: Ex 23:17-17; Dt 16:16-17
- Feast of Booths Lev 23:34; Dt 16:13, 16; 31:9-13; Zech 14:16-19
- Trajectory of OT Promise to NT Fulfillment in Christ: Mat 5:17; Lk 24:27, 44; 2 Cor 1:19-20. Example: Gen 12:1-3; 17:19; Gal 3:16, 24.

Consider & Discuss (Be Transformed!)

- What was the Feast of Booths?
- How has John been using Jewish feasts in his gospel?
- How might John be using the Feast of Booths for His purposes here?
- Why did Jesus not go up according to the time His brothers demanded?
- What was the difference between Jesus brothers' timing and Jesus' timing?
- What was the effect of Jesus delay in the thought life of the Jews?
- **Community Group Question: By looking at Jesus' brothers' good ideas about what He should have done, how can we temper our own good ideas about what God should do in our own lives? If we are to be provoked as Jesus intended to provoke the Jews celebrating the Feast of Booths, what questions should be on our minds as we study what He went on to say?**
