# The Basics Exodus 35:1-19

#### We are called to:

- **I.** Obedience –"the LORD hath commanded" (vs. 1-3) *Embracing:* 
  - A. Labor "Six days shall work be done"
  - B. Leaning "the seventh day...to you a holy day"
  - C. Leadership "no fire throughout your habitations"
- **II.** Offerings —"an offering of the LORD" (vs. 4-9)

  Enjoy being:
  - A. Invited "Moses spake unto all the congregation"
  - **B.** Inclined "whosoever is of a willing heart"
  - C. Involved "let him bring it"
- III. Occupation –"come, and make all...commanded"(vs. 10-19)

  Employed to:
  - A. Skill "every wise hearted among you"
  - **B.** Submission "all that the LORD commanded"
  - C. Service "to do service in the holy"
