## "Angry With Your Brother?" Coming To The Table in the Spirit Of The Sixth Commandment

Acts 2:46; Matt. 5:21-24; Exodus 20:1-13 The Voice From The Fire Part 8 of 12

As we come to the Lord's Table, the sixth commandment brings a pointed message: do not murder humans with your hand or hate your brother in your heart. Human beings are God's image-bearers (though corrupted), therefore human life is sacred and must never be taken unlawfully (remember Gen 9:6 & Ro. 13:4).
