Those whom the Holy Spirit vivifies are done with vain glory. 5:26

Understanding vain glory.

To glory is to boast

Vain glory is a departure from glorying in God.

1 Corinthians 10:31 Whether, then, you eat or drink or whatever you do, do all to the glory of God.

1 Corinthians 1:31 so that, just as it is written, "LET HIM WHO BOASTS, BOAST IN THE LORD."

Galatians 6:14

The vain glory of the Dark Ages.

The vain glory of the enlightenment.

Scripture denounces vain glory.

Psalm 100:3 Know that the LORD Himself is God; It is He who has made us, and not we ourselves; We are His people and the sheep of His pasture.

Isaiah 46:5 "To whom would you liken Me And make Me equal and compare Me, That we would be alike? **8** "Remember this, and be assured; Recall it to mind, you transgressors. **9** "Remember the former things long past, For I am God, and there is no other; I am God, and there is no one like Me, **10** Declaring the end from the beginning, And from ancient times things which have not been done, Saying, 'My purpose will be established, And I will accomplish all My good pleasure';
