## "All Authority And Power" The Word Of Jesus On A Sabbath In Capernaum

Luke 4:31-44

After Nazareth rejected Jesus' teachings he travelled 30 miles northwest to the shores of the Sea of Galilee, preaching another sermon on another Sabbath in another town – this time in Capernaum. A later synagogue is reconstructed on the site, but foundation stones of the Jesus-era synagogue are completely visible. On this Sabbath Day three incidents graphically displayed how Jesus exercised his sovereign power in the simplest way possible: just by speaking a word. With this divine and effectual (effective) word, Jesus exercises three different kinds of authority. And Luke carefully shows us how people responded to that authority.
