The Global Glory of the Gospel Fulfilled
Isaiah 60

- I. God's Glory on Zion (1-3)
 - A. God's light and glory have come and arisen
 - B. Many will be in darkness, but not Zion
 - C. Notice the transition: nations (those in darkness) will come to Zion's light
- II. Observe God's Glorious Work (4-9)
 - A. Look and see what is happening and rejoice in it
 - B. What is taking place? The global ingathering
 - 1. The wealth, abundance, and best of all nations
 - 2. The people, designated as "your sons and daughters" (cf. Psalm 87:3-6; Galatians 4:26)
 - C. God has glorified Zion, because He is in Zion and Zion is in Him
- III. What Is The Glorious, Global Zion Like? (10-22)
 - A. It will be built up by foreigners (10)
 - B. Its gates will never be shut [Revelation 21:25-26] (11)
 - C. It will be an unending kingdom that brings nation/state distinctions to an end (12)
 - D. It will be beautiful, on purpose (13)
 - E. The enemy will be overwhelmed by the place and its God (14)
 - F. The "city" will be great because of God's work (15-17)
 - G. No need for the sun or moon, because of God's presence [Revelation 21:23] (18-20)
 - H. The people will become a permanent, righteous establishment, fully displaying the glory of God (21)
 - I. God will make the small great (22)
 - J. When it happens, it will happen in haste (23)
