Parenthood Week 2

The Ministry of the Family

- I. Review The family is central to God's revelation
 - a. Presents a portrait of God Himself and a portrait of the purpose of the gospel.
 - b. A family cultivating the characteristics in these 2 portraits is vital to the family's health, growth, and ministry.
- II. The family ministers to the local church.
 - a. The family presents a portrait of what the church ought to be, and as it becomes more like that portrait, it increasingly ministers to the local church.

Romans 12:10; Galatians 6:10; Ephesians 2:19; 1 Thessalonians 2:7-8 & 10-11, 4:9-10; 1 Timothy 3:4-5 & 14-15, 5:1-2; James 2:15-16; 1 Peter 4:17; 1 John 3:17. b. A beautiful symbiosis – the family blesses the church and the church blesses the family

III. The family ministers to <u>the world</u> - We should view building strong families as a form of ministry to the world.
