Coexist 2: Will Muhammad or Jesus Bow?

I Text:

Old Covenant: Joshua 5

New Covenant: Philippians 2:1-11

II Doctrine: Jesus Christ is the God-man sent by our Father in heaven to rule and reign over creation. No other name under heaven carries the same authority. All false gods, demons, and prophets, will be judged and kneel to the King. This includes Islam and it's prophet Muhammad, who pay superficial homage to Jesus in the Quran. He is acknowleged as a prophet with supernatural power, yet his work at the cross is denied. Islam is simply another works based religion void of grace. The five pillars of Islam cannot coexist with the Gospel of Jesus Christ. We do not criticize Islam out of arrogance, but as fellow sinners who through Christ are redeemed and on God's side.

III Application:

1) The God-King Jesus Christ represents the interests of his Father in heaven, and favors no group of people on earth. God is not on "our side", we must be on his side. (2 Corinthians 5:11-21)

2) There is no salvation outside of the work of Jesus Christ on the cross. (Luke 23:26-43)

3) The five (works) pillars of Islam do not bring salvation. (5 Pillars Article)

4) Christian Nations and communities can prevent evil by enforcing God's moral law in the public square. (*Excerpt from Prime Minister Viktor Orbán's speech at the 29th Bálványos Summer Open University and Student Camp*)

Mistake: Mary the sister of Aaron

Surah 19:27-28, "At length she brought the (babe) to her people, carrying him (in her arms). They said: "O Mary! Truly an amazing thing hast thou brought! 28. "O sister of Aaron! Thy father was not a man of evil, nor thy mother a woman unchaste!"

Mistake: Mary, the mother of Jesus, was not the sister of Aaron. Aaron was born about 2000 years before Mary. This is another example of an error made in the Quran.
