- The Second Commandment – vs 4 – 6
  - Prohibited The Construction Of Idols - “Thou shalt not make unto thee any graven image”
  
  - Prohibited The Worship Of Idols - “Thou shalt not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them...”
    - Worship Through Submission - “bow down thyself...”
    - Worship Through Service - “...nor serve them
  
  - Pronounced A Characteristic Of God - “for I the LORD thy God *am* a jealous God...”
  
  - Description Of Consequences
    - A Negative Consequence
    - A Positive Consequence
- The Third Commandment – vs 7
  - The Accountability Of The Action - “for the LORD will not hold him guiltless that taketh his name in vain.”
- The Fourth Commandment – vs 8 – 11
  - Starts With A Reminder – “Remember The Sabbath...”
  
  - Then A Direction Is Given - “...keep it holy...”
