Colossians Chapter 1 Part 3

Col. 1:24 Who now **rejoice in my sufferings for you (2Tim.3:12)**, and fill up that which is behind of the afflictions of Christ in my flesh for his body's sake, which is the church:

Paul gloried in his sufferings. Both Jesus and Paul promised that suffering would come to a dedicated follower of Christ who stands for the Word of God. It can result in the following things...

Hatred - John 15:19 If ye were of the world, the world would love his own: but because ye are not of the world, but I have chosen you out of the world, therefore the world hateth you. If Jesus said it, you can believe it!

Loss of Things – Phil. 3:8 Yea doubtless, and I count all things *but* loss for the excellency of the knowledge of Christ Jesus my Lord: for whom I have **suffered the loss of all things**, and do count them *but* dung, that I may win Christ, **Mistreatment** - **1Pet.2:20** For what glory *is it*, if, when ye be buffeted for your faults, ye shall take it patiently? but if, **when ye do well, and suffer** *for it*, ye take it patiently, this *is* acceptable with God. Even physical harm (Gal. 6:17).

Col. 1:25-27 Whereof I am made a minister, according to **the** <u>dispensation</u> of **God which is given to me for you**, to fulfil the word of God; **26** *Even* **the mystery which hath been hid from ages and from generations**, but now is made manifest to his saints: **27** To whom God would make known what *is* the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles; **which is Christ** <u>in you</u>, the hope of glory: No man in the Old Testament had Jesus Christ dwelling inside him although they did have "the Spirit of Christ" (1Pet.1:10-12).

Col. 1:28-29 Whom we <u>preach</u>, warning every man, and teaching every man in all wisdom; that we may present every man perfect in Christ Jesus: **29** Whereunto I also labour, striving according to his working, which worketh in me mightily. Preaching ought to be the foundation of every N.T. church (Ps.40:9, 2Tim.4:2). It manifests the word of God (Tit.1:3). It is the power of God to the Christian (1Cor.1:18). It pleases God and saves the sinner (1Cor.1:21). It warns, teaches, reproves, rebukes, exhorts, corrects, and contains good doctrine.

Colossians Chapter 2

Col. 2:1-3 For I would that ye knew **what great conflict I have for you**, and *for* them at Laodicea, and *for* as many as have not seen my face in the flesh; **2** That their hearts might be comforted, **being knit together in love**, and unto all riches of the **full assurance of understanding**, to the acknowledgement of the mystery of God, and of the Father, and of Christ; **3 In whom are hid** all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge.

Paul had a great conflict for his converts. His desire was that they would be knit together in love and have a full assurance in whom they have believed. That they might apprehend that for which they were apprehended – Phil. 3:12. **Vs. 3** – "hid" implies that we must search for it (Pro.2:1-5, 25:2, 18:1). The world has no answers. The answer is in Jesus. All of life's mysteries are solved in him but a fool has no delight in understanding Pro.18:2.

Furthermore, there are seven mysteries spoken of in 1Cor.4:1 that every Christian (*and certainly every church*) is supposed to be a steward of. **1.**) the incarnation of Christ, 1Tim.3:16. **2.**) the incarnation of Satan, 2Th.2:7. **3.**) the indwelling of Christ, Col.1:27. **4.**) the body of Christ, Eph.1:22-23, 3:6. **5.**) the blindness of Israel, Rom.11:25. **6.**) the rapture, 1Cor.15:51. **7.**) Babylon the Great, Rev.17:5.
