Sermon: "Yearning For Reassurance." What's Wrong With You People? Pt. 21

I Text:

Old Covenant: *Judges 7:9-14*

New Covenant: *Luke 22:31-38*

II Doctrine:

Just like all God's children Gideon needs reassurance. Even though he has been given multiple signs declaring his victory, his faith is still wavering.

God in his mercy wants Gideon to be fully confident in his victory. The Lord tells Gideon to journey into the enemy camp himself with Phurah. Gideon embraces on a spying mission to evaluate the enemy.

Gideon and Phurah overhear a dream one of the enemy soldiers. The man dreamed of a lowly barley cake which rolled into their tents and knocked them down. Phurah exclaimed to Gideon this is a word from the Lord guaranteeing their victory. God's will cannot be stopped by our lack of faith. Our faith gives us the privilege to be used as God's vessel to accomplish his will.

III Comparing Scripture With Scripture:

2) God in his mercy wants Gideon to be fully confident in his victory. The Lord tells Gideon to journey into the enemy camp himself with Phurah. Gideon embraces on a spying mission to evaluate the enemy. (*Judges 7:11-13; Deuteronomy 20:1-9*)

3) Gideon and Phurah overhear a dream one of the enemy soldiers. The man dreamed of a lowly barley cake which rolled into their tents and knocked them down. Phurah exclaimed to Gideon this is a word from the Lord guaranteeing their victory. God's will cannot be stopped by our lack of faith. Our faith gives us the privilege to be used as God's vessel to accomplish his will. (*Judges 7:14*)
