## Confession of Sin

Pastor: The 1st Commandment say," "You shall have no other Gods before Me."
People: We confess that we have preferred other things and people above You, merciful God.
Pastor: $\quad$ The 2nd Commandment says "You shall not make for yourself an idol."
People: We confess that we have had vain imaginations and false thoughts about You and we have set up ungodly objects for our adoration.
Pastor: The 3rd Commandment says "You shall not take the Name of the Lord your God in vain. '"
People: We confess that we have often used Your Name lightly, not always keeping it holy - as we ought, and we have slandered it by our lives and deeds.
