Introduction: A trip down the shore: On Waves and Life

Book 2 of the Psalter begins where Book 1 left off.

Who are "the sons of Korah?"

I. Summary of Psalm 42

A lamentation song, written from the perspective of an Israelite who, for one reason or another, was hindered from worshipping in the temple in Jerusalem.

- v. 1-3: Thirst for the presence of the living God
- v. 9-10: What might be keeping him away?
- v. 4 & 6-7: The corporate gathering in Jerusalem
- v. 8: A brief respite from the waves
- v. 9-10: Another wave
- v. 5, 11: The Psalmist interrogates his soul
- Ps. 43:1-2: From lamentation to prayer
- 43:3-4: the turning point: Faith!
