Understanding Faith

Heb. 12:1-3

Therefore, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us also lay aside every weight, and sin which clings so closely, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us,

looking to Jesus, the founder and perfector of our faith, who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is seated at the right hand of the throne of God.

Consider Him who endured from sinners such hostility against Himself, so that you may not grow weary or fainthearted.

When the Son of Man comes will He find faith on earth? Lk. 18:8

Faith is weak when we...

Focus on the "wind" (or circumstances)

But when he saw the wind he was afraid. Matt. 14:30 Fear -

- A night of rowing exhausted
- A ghost on the water? unknown

- A storm that grabbed his focus – "I'm drowning!"

Peter had enough faith ---

- to ask if he could walk on water.
- to get out of the boat.
- to walk on water But then...

Jesus immediately reached out His hand and took hold of him, saying to him, "O you of little faith, why did you doubt?" Matt. 14:31

2. Focus on the wisdom of the world.

... That your faith might not rest in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God. 1 Cor. 2:5

Wisdom of men

- . Source is man's ideas or opinions
- . Source is what is popular or acceptable
- . Source is what sounds comfortable.

Hinduism

"Man is god - in a temporary state of self-forgetfulness."

3. Focus on my will

But let him ask in faith, with no doubting... James 1:6

... a double minded man, unstable in all his ways. (8)

No longer be children, tossed to and fro by the waves and carried about by every wind of doctrine by human cunning, by craftiness in deceitful schemes. Eph. 4:14

Purify your hearts, you double-minded. James 4:8

2. Focus on His Word
