### AWP:

*If left to himself, the believer would never see* (by faith) the all-wise hand of God in his afflictions, still less would his heart ever honestly say concerning them, THY WILL BE DONE. If left to himself, he would never seek grace to patiently endure the trial, still less would *he hope that afterwards, it would produce the* peaceable fruit of righteousness. If left to himself, he would continue to chafe and kick like "an ox unaccustomed to the yoke", and would curse the day of his birth. If left to himself, he would have no faith that his sufferings were among the "all things" working together for his ultimate good, still less would he "glory in his infirmity that the power of Christ might rest upon him." Such holy exercises of heart are NOT the product of poor fallen human nature; instead, they are nothing less that the immediate, gracious, and lovely fruits of *the Holy Spirit — brought forth amid such uncongenial* soil. What a marvel!
