\_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_

- I. One's focusing on God \_\_\_\_\_ one's attitude and behavior Vs 1-13
- A. An attitude of \_\_\_\_\_ develops in the believer Vs 1-7
1. **Extol**-exalt to a place of \_\_\_\_\_ in one's mind and thinking Vs 1a
  2. **Bless**-praise and speak \_\_\_\_\_ of Vs 1b
  3. Exalting and blessing the Lord illustrated Vs 2-7
    - a. I will bless thee/I will praise thy name for ever and ever Vs 2
    - b. Great is the Lord/greatly to be praised Vs 3
    - c. Praise thy works/declare thy mighty acts Vs 4
    - d. Speak of thy glorious honor, majesty and might acts Vs 5
    - e. I will declare thy greatness Vs 6
    - f. Sing of thy righteousness Vs 7
- B. An examination of God's \_\_\_\_\_ begins Vs 8-9
1. **Gracious**-\_\_\_\_\_ of grace (God giving us what we do not deserve, and cannot earn) Vs 8a
  2. **Compassionate**-moved to mercy \_\_\_\_\_ of wrath upon His own Vs 8b
    - a. Slow to anger
    - b. Great in mercy
  3. Goodness to \_\_\_\_\_ living Vs 9a
  4. Tender to all his \_\_\_\_\_ Vs 9b
- C. An \_\_\_\_\_ of God's might and power begins to unfold itself Vs 10-13
1. God's \_\_\_\_\_ brings praise to Himself Vs 10a
  2. God's children begin to \_\_\_\_\_ his character Vs 10b-12
  3. God's Kingdom becomes more of a \_\_\_\_\_ to the believer Vs 13
- II. One begins to understand that God is \_\_\_\_\_ : Vs 14-20
- A. To \_\_\_\_\_ the fallen one Vs 14a
1. **Uphold**-become someone on which one can \_\_\_\_\_ for support
  2. **Fallen one**-those who are not perfect—each \_\_\_\_\_
- B. To \_\_\_\_\_ the bowed-down one Vs 14b
1. **Raise**-give \_\_\_\_\_ to
  2. **Bowed down one**-one \_\_\_\_\_ with the issues of everyday life
- C. To \_\_\_\_\_ meat in due season Vs 15
1. **Give meat**-provide the \_\_\_\_\_ of life
  2. **Due season**-when they are \_\_\_\_\_
  3. Cf Matthew 6:33
- D. To \_\_\_\_\_ the ones who are alive Vs 16
1. God is the \_\_\_\_\_ provider of true satisfaction
  2. **Satisfy**-\_\_\_\_\_ the dissatisfaction with life and living
- E. To rightly guide \_\_\_\_\_ of his holiness Vs 17
- F. To comfort those who \_\_\_\_\_ in him Vs 18
- G. To \_\_\_\_\_ the desires of those that fear Him Vs 19a
1. **Fulfill**-\_\_\_\_\_
  2. **Desires**-the good \_\_\_\_\_
  3. **Fear Him**-to hold in a place of \_\_\_\_\_ and reverence in one's mind and thinking

H. To \_\_\_\_\_ those who cry out to Him for deliverance **Vs 19b**

1. **Cry**-a cry for \_\_\_\_\_ from something or someone
2. **Save**-bring deliverance or \_\_\_\_\_

I. To \_\_\_\_\_ those who love Him **Vs 20**

1. **Preserve**-to guard and protect from \_\_\_\_\_
2. **Love Him**-He is the \_\_\_\_\_ of their attention; He is the one whom they wish to please; He is the one to whom they have given their allegiance.
