Romans 12:2 OT: 2 Kings 17:6-15

Theme: Living in the world with the mind of Christ puts us in opposition to the ways, ideals and desires of the world. But it also leads to a peace that passes understanding as we discern, obey and rest in the will of God.

Background / Introduction / Review:

- 1. I can't always trust my thoughts. I can always trust God's Word.
- 2. Feed your mind well. (Phil 4:8)

I. Resist the World's Mold

- A. Not Conformed
 - 1. Israel lost its way (2 Kings 17:16ff)
 - Conforming to the nations
 - With dreadful consequences
 - 2. A danger to the church
 - False teachers
 - Keeping watch
 - 3. Compromise (with the world) is impossible

A Tough Question?? Where have I conformed to the world, likely without noticing it?

B. But Transformed

- 1. Renewing the mind (2 Corinthians 3:18) - Being "transformed"
 - a. The work of the Spirit
 - b. The work of the Word
- 2. The Will of God
 - a) "Prove" it!
 - discern and determine to obey
 - Know and Do!
 - b) Good, acceptable (pleasing), perfect

II. Live By Conviction

A. Fixed on what is true (Colossians 3:2) - Have an eternal perspective

II. Live By Conviction (cont.)

- B. Forming strong convictions (*Pursuit of Holiness*, Jerry Bridges)
 - 1. Is it helpful? (1 Corinthians 6:12)
 - Permissible vs. Helpful
 - Helpful physically, spiritually, mentally, relationally
 - 2. Does it have power over me? (1 Corinthians 6:12)Permitted but not mastered by it

A Tough Question: Does this drive my decisions, actions? Does it exerts control over other obligations (spiritual, relational, vocational)??

- 3. Does it hurt others? (1 Corinthians 8:13)Do I exercise my freedom in Christ, even if it hurts others?
- 4. Does it Glorify God? (1 Corinthians 10:31)
 - Is God glorified in this thought?
 - in this desire?
 - in these words?
 - in this activity (whether at my eyes, ears)

III. Learn to Pray – Continuously (Philippians 4:6,7)

- Don't worry about anything. Pray about everything.

- To have mind of Christ - stay in constant conversation with him

IV. Live in Union and Communion with Christ

Are you convinced:

- Christ has risen from the dead and you will be raised
- Nothing can separate you from the love of Christ
- He will never leave you nor forsake you
- You have been filled with the Holy Spirit that you might know the truth and walk in it.
- That the Word of God is living, active and sharper than any two edged sword.
