Galatians 1:11-24

The accusations against Paul: invented his own gospel

- 1. He was not one of the Twelve
- Appointed himself an apostle (man-made, self-ordained)

Paul's defense of his gospel: gospel was revealed to him by God, not man

- 1. Prior to conversion, he hated Christ (13-14)
- 2 At conversion, divinely summoned (15-16a; cf. Acts 9:1-6)
- 3. After conversion, preached divine revelation; served (16b-24)

Observations/applications

- The gospel is not man-made but divine (11-12), emphasizing grace not works
- 2. Those seeking holiness through works miss the gospel (13-14)
- 3. Salvation comes to all whom God has set apart for Christ (15-16)
- Those whom God saves are also called to service (16b)
- 5. In our service to God, what others think of us matters not (17-19)
- 6. When we preach faithfully yet remain unknown, we serve faithfully (22)
- 7. We are our best evangelistic witness (23)
- 8. Christians glorify God when we serve faithfully (24)
