	God's promise of the Spirit to indwell believers.

C.	There is only one baptism for the Christians and the church.

	1. He did not indwell those in the Old Testament.	
	2. He did not indwell the Apostles during Jesus' earthly ministry.	
	3. His indwelling of believers was initiated at Pentecost.

	are saved.
