¹ And God spake all these words, saying, ² I *am* the LORD thy God, which have brought thee out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of bondage. ³ Thou shalt have no other gods before me.

⁴ Thou shalt not make unto thee any graven image, or any likeness of *any thing* that *is* in heaven above, or that *is* in the earth beneath, or that *is* in the water under the earth: ⁵ Thou shalt not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them: for I the LORD thy God *am* a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth *generation* of them that hate me; ⁶ And shewing mercy unto thousands of them that love me, and keep my commandments.

⁷ Thou shalt not take the name of the LORD thy God in vain; for the LORD will not hold him guiltless that taketh his name in vain.

⁸ Remember the sabbath day, to keep it holy. ⁹ Six days shalt thou labour, and do all thy work: ¹⁰ But the seventh day *is* the sabbath of the LORD thy God: *in it* thou shalt not do any work, thou, nor thy son, nor thy daughter, thy manservant, nor thy maidservant, nor thy cattle, nor thy stranger that *is* within thy gates: ¹¹ For *in* six days the LORD made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that in them *is*, and rested the seventh day: wherefore the LORD blessed the sabbath day, and hallowed it.

¹² Honour thy father and thy mother: that thy days may be long upon the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee.

¹³ Thou shalt not kill.

¹⁴ Thou shalt not commit adultery.

¹⁵ Thou shalt not steal.

¹⁶ Thou shalt not bear false witness against thy neighbour.

¹⁷ Thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's house, thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's wife, nor his manservant, nor his maidservant, nor his ox, nor his ass, nor any thing that *is* thy neighbour's.

**BENEDICTION AND DISMISSAL

QUESTION: HOW WAS CHRIST EXALTED IN HIS RESURRECTION?

ANSWER:

CHRIST WAS EXALTED IN HIS RESURRECTION, IN THAT, NOT HAVING SEEN CORRUPTION IN DEATH, (OF WHICH IT WAS NOT POSSIBLE FOR HIM TO BE HELD,^A) AND HAVING THE VERY SAME BODY IN WHICH HE SUFFERED, WITH THE ESSENTIAL PROPERTIES THEREOF,^B(BUT WITHOUT MORTALITY, AND OTHER INFIRMITIES BELONGING TO THIS LIFE,) REALLY UNITED TO HIS SOUL,^C HE ROSE AGAIN FROM THE DEAD THE THIRD DAY BY HIS OWN POWER;^D WHEREBY HE DECLARED HIMSELF TO BE THE SON OF GOD,^E TO HAVE SATISFIED DIVINE JUSTICE,^F TO HAVE VANQUISHED DEATH, AND HIM THAT HAD THE POWER OF IT,^G AND TO BE LORD OF QUICK AND DEAD:^H ALL WHICH HE DID AS A PUBLIC PERSON,^I THE HEAD OF HIS CHURCH,^J FOR THEIR JUSTIFICATION,^K QUICKENING IN GRACE,^L SUPPORT AGAINST ENEMIES,^M AND TO ASSURE THEM OF THEIR RESURRECTION FROM THE DEAD AT THE LAST DAY.^N
