God Pursues His People Jonah 1:4-9

Main Point:

God always lovingly pursues His wayward people; therefore, give thanks to Him and repent early of your sins.

1. When you run away from God, it can sometimes seem that you have gotten away with it.

2. But you will never get away with it because God always pursues His people in love.

3. And, in doing so, God will eventually bring you to conviction and confession of sin.

4. Therefore, give thanks for His love and repent early of your sins.
