**I. Doctrine: *Gideon's Fleece* Reminds us that God is Very**

- B. . . . Even Long \_\_\_\_\_ our Assurance *should have*  
*been Well-Established*, (Judg. 6:38)

**II. What the Church is to \_\_\_\_\_ of *Gideon's Fleece*,**

**vv. 36-40**

- A. –That Believers are Often \_\_\_\_\_—Despite  
God's Overt Clarity, vv. 36-37
- B. –That God is \_\_\_\_\_—Being Willing to Condescend to us,  
v. 38
- C. –That our Lord is \_\_\_\_\_ Forbearing—Being Willing to  
Accommodate our Weakness, vv. 39-40

**III. What we are to \_\_\_\_\_ Today, from *Gideon's Fleece***

- A. –That God is *Most Honored* when we Walk by \_\_\_\_\_  
(and Not by Sight) . . . , (2 Cor. 5:7)
- B. . . . *But That* He WILL *at times* \_\_\_\_\_ Confirm  
us, (when necessary), (Judg. 6:40)

**Key Verse—v. 40: “And God did so that night. It was dry on the fleece only, but there was dew on all the ground.”**
