Main thought: We can delight in God's Word even when our souls are worn and weary.

- 1. A **<u>path</u>** to be chosen. (v.1)
- 2. A place to delight. (v.2)
- 3. A **purpose** to grow. (v.3)

Ice-Breaker

• Where do you find the greatest joy and happiness in your week? (Maybe it is a hobby, a person, an item, etc,)

Verse of the week

• What is a verse or truth from God's Word that has stood out to you this week from your own personal Bible reading?

Digging In

Read Psalm 1:1-3, and discuss the following questions.

- What stood out to you from the message on Sunday?
- It is easy to see the path of the wicked in our day. How does this path creep into your daily life, stealing the delight you have in Jesus?
- What keeps us from meditating on the instructions of the Lord both day and night? Share some personal examples of how you keep God's Word in front of you on a daily basis.
- Look at John 15:1-8. How do the Psalmist's words mirror those of Jesus? Discuss the relationship of abiding to bearing good fruit.

Application

• Begin to find delight in the Word of God this week. Take time to read, reflect, and recite the goodness of God revealed through His Word.

As a group pray as you consider the following:

• How are we praying to encourage one another to delight in the Word of God?
