## **Closed Doors**

Acts 16:6-15 Pastor Phil Winfield August 7, 2016

<u>Pr 16:9</u> A man's heart plans his way, But the LORD directs his steps.

Divine directives in confusing circumstances.

- 1. God can direct us by **<u>closing a door</u>** [v.6-8].
  - a. When God closes a door he is not **<u>cancelling</u>** the mission.
  - b. God was not changing <u>what</u> they were to do (preach Jesus); he was changing <u>where</u> they were to do it.
  - c. We are called to a **person** more than to a **place**.
- 2. God will direct us from his divine **perspective** [v.9-10].
  - a. God knows where people are **<u>begging</u>** for the truth (v.9).
  - b. God knows which servants are **predetermined** for obedience (v.10).
- 3. God will direct to **places** where he is working (v.11-12).
- 4. God will direct to people that are truly **<u>seeking</u>** (v.13-15).
- 5. God directs according to his **sovereignty** (v.6-15).

Get this:

- Closed doors need not discourage your heart nor <u>close</u> your mouth. God is working.
- Predetermine to obey God even **<u>before</u>** you know the whole plan.
- God calls people to go because he is also calling someone to listen.
- One simple act of <u>obedience</u> may open a door much bigger than we can imagine.
- Have you responded to the gospel like Lydia?
