INTRODUCTION: YOU CAN DO IT

It seems to me one of the strangest forms of encouragement, "You can do it."

The heart of communion is realizing that Jesus did for us there, what we could never do for ourselves.

- ? How dependent is the sinner on the cross of Jesus?
- ? How much of salvation is God's work and how much is ours?

I. WE NEED GRACE, VV. 1-3

Isaiah 59:2

but your iniquities have made a separation between you and your God, and your sins have hidden His face from you so that He does not hear.

If anyone is saved from hell, it is by God's grace alone through faith alone in Christ alone not of works.

II. GOD EXTENDS GRACE

Grace

Undeserved gift of favor/kindness; the Lovingkindness of God.

III. GOD IS RICH IN MERCY

Mercy

Undeserved compassion that leads to forgiveness.

IV. GOD LOVES US WITH GREAT LOVE

Love

Unconditional affection that sacrifices for the good of another.

V. GOD MAKES US ALIVE WITH CHRIST

A. HE MADE US ALIVE...

Titus 3:5-7

He saved us, not on the basis of deeds which we have done in righteousness, but according to His mercy, by the washing of regeneration and renewing by the Holy Spirit, whom He poured out upon us richly through Jesus Christ our Savior, so that being justified by His grace we would be made heirs according to *the* hope of eternal life.

B. ...WITH CHRIST
