- A. Daniel's 1st vision was a sweeping view of all history; his second has a narrower focus.
- B. The vision regarded the future the future power of an earthly king, and its effect on God's people.

<u>Daniel: God's Antithetical, Indestructible, Triumphant Kingdom (10)</u> The Power and Destruction of the Little Horn

- I. Warring Against Jehovah.
 - A. The text speaks of the rise to power of a king, represented by the little horn.
 - B. This king manifested his wickedness by intentionally warring against Jehovah.
- II. Destroyed by Jehovah.
 - A. This little horn, Jehovah destroyed, triumphing over the kings of the earth.
 - B. The timing of this destruction Jehovah appointed in His counsel.
 - C. Also the reason for the success of this little horn, and the reason why he was finally destroyed, Jehovah governed.
- III. Awaited by the People of Jehovah.
 - A. Implied in the text is that the people of God must wait patiently for our troubles to end.
 - B. How are we to show that we are waiting?
