

## Behold Your GOD!! No One like Him


SERMON NOTES: August 8th, 2021

## Scripture Text: Isaiah 46 (ESV)

<sup>1</sup>Bel bows down; Nebo stoops; their idols are on beasts and livestock: these things you carry are borne as burdens on weary beasts. <sup>2</sup>They stoop; they bow down together; they cannot save the burden, but themselves go into captivity. <sup>3</sup>"Listen to me, O house of Jacob, all the remnant of the house of Israel, who have been borne by me from before your birth, carried from the womb: <sup>4</sup>even to your old age I am he, and to gray hairs I will carry you. I have made, and I will bear; I will carry and will save. <sup>5</sup>"To whom will you liken me and make me equal, and compare me, that we may be alike? <sup>6</sup>Those who lavish gold from the purse, and weigh out silver in the scales, hire a goldsmith, and he makes it into a god; then they fall down and worship! <sup>7</sup>They lift it to their shoulders, they carry it, they set it in its place, and it stands there; it cannot move from its place. If one cries to it, it does not answer or save him from his trouble. <sup>8</sup>"Remember this and stand firm, recall it to mind, you transgressors, <sup>9</sup>remember the former things of old; for I am God, and there is no other; I am God, and there is none like me, <sup>10</sup>declaring the end from the beginning and from ancient times things not yet done, saying, 'My counsel shall stand, and I will accomplish all my purpose,' <sup>11</sup>calling a bird of prev from the east. the man of my counsel from a far country. I have spoken, and I will bring it to pass; I have purposed, and I will do it. <sup>12</sup>"Listen to me, you stubborn of heart, you who are far from righteousness: <sup>13</sup>I bring near my righteousness; it is not far off, and my salvation will not delay; I will put salvation in Zion, for Israel my glory."
