Abide in Jesus, the true Vine, so that you bear much fruit and are useful to Him.

1. Spiritual fruitlessness is a problem in the church.

2. Spiritual fruitlessness makes you useless to the LORD.

3. Spiritual fruitlessness leads to the burning fires of God's wrath.

4. Spiritual fruitlessness is overcome by abiding in Jesus, the true Vine.

**Psalm 80:8** 8 You have brought a vine out of Egypt; You have cast out the nations, and planted it. (NKJV)

**Isaiah 5:1-2** 1 ... My Well-beloved has a vineyard On a very fruitful hill. 2 He dug it up and cleared out its stones, And planted it with the choicest vine. He built a tower in its midst, And also made a winepress in it; So He expected *it* to bring forth *good* grapes But it brought forth wild grapes. (NKJV)

**2 Timothy 2:21** 21 ... If anyone cleanses himself ..., he will be a vessel for honor, sanctified and useful for the Master, prepared for every good work. (NKJV)

**John 15:4-5** 4 Abide in Me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you abide in Me. 5 "I am the vine, you are the branches. He who abides in Me, and I in him, bears much fruit; for without Me you can do nothing. (NKJV)
