The absence of sin Rev. 21: 27

The absence of sorrow & pain Rev. 21: 4

4) The presence of loved ones- John 17: 24

a. A concern for the needs of others- vs. 24, 25b

b. A confidence in the timing of God v.25a; Psa 31: 15

c. A commitment to glorify Christ - V. 26
