I. THE HUGE BENEFIT OF TRUE SAVING FAITH

A. Saving faith makes us partakers of Christ and all His benefits

1. Scriptures to support this: John 1:12; 1 Cor 3:21-22; Eph. 1:3; 11-14; 18

- II. THE DIVINE AUTHOR OF TRUE SAVING FAITH
- A. Scripture teaches squarely that saving faith is God's work
  - 1. Take John 6:44

2. Take Eph. 2:8 (with 1:13; 1:19-20)

## III. THE SIMPLE MEANS

A. Holy Spirit does not work faith miraculously: Romans 10:14-17

- 1. See examples in Matt 28:19-20; Acts 8: 31; Acts 9:4; Acts 10:44; Acts 16:14
- 2. Observe that it is not *the law* preaching that brings to saving faith a. law discovers sin and convicts of sin but leaves us lost
  - b. but only Gospel preaching bring to faith: Rom. 1:17; Gal. 3:2
- B. What is the Gospel? 2 Cor. 5:19ff; Mark 16:15

1. That God has not pleasure to leave you where you are: Ezek. 33:11

2. That God has pleasure in the death of His Son to reconcile Himself to the world of sinners: 2 Cor. 5:19

- 3. That God assures that Jesus is the suitable and available Savior for you: John 1:29
- 4. That you are invited to trust Him as your willing and able Savior: John 3:16
- C. But *how* does preaching the Gospel work faith in us? 1. How is not clear: Eccl. 11:5; Canons ¾,13
  - 2. But that it does is clear in fruits: Acts 13:48b; John 6; Ezek. 36:26; Ezek. 37

**Reflection:** *Though Spirit works faith, He does not do it in same manner or order* A. His most common way

- 1. He convinces you of your sinful, lost, and condemnable state
- 2. Upon His *preparatory* work, the Holy Spirit brings one to faith in Jesus! a. He reveals Jesus Christ through the preaching of the Gospel
  - b. He overcomes doubts and fears through ongoing preaching of Gospel
  - c. He enables our soul to embrace Jesus in faith upon His offer
- B. His other ways of leading sinners are no less glorious
  - 1. He can sweetly open the heart in one sermon to embrace Jesus (Acts 16:14) or through one sudden event (Acts 16:31-33)
  - 2. Some hear the call of the Gospel "Follow Me" without seeking it and follow Him at once: Matt. 9:9
  - 3. Others are suddenly overwhelmed & filled with love of Jesus: Luke 19:1-10
  - 4. Many receive saving faith in Jesus in their early youth: Samuel, John Baptist
- C. But all the different ways end the same: He increase, and I decrease!

It requires not only a power, but an almighty power, to raise the heart of man to believe the Gospel of Jesus Christ. (Richard Sibbes)
