I. Jesus calls disciples.

- A.** God must call disciples (Ro. 3:9-20; Pro. 1:5; Ps. 51:10; Jn 6:44, 65; Ro. 1:6; Jn. 11:43-44).
- B.** Pray for God to call disciples (Mt. 9:38; Lk. 10:2).
 - 1.** Pray for enemies (Mt. 5:44).
 - 2.** Pray for family (Ro. 9:1-3; 10:1; 11:1).
 - 3.** Pray for those in authority (1 Tim. 2:2).
 - 4.** Pray for all people (1 Tim. 2:1).

II. Disciples are with Jesus.

- A.** Disciples stay with him in his trials (Lk. 22:28-30).
- B.** Disciples are changed by being with him (Acts 4:13).
- C.** Disciples witness (1 Pt. 5:1; 1 Jn. 1:1-3).
- D.** Jesus wants us to do it the way he does it (1 Thess. 2:7-14; 2 Cor. 6:2-13; 7:2-7; 1 Cor. 4:14-17; Acts 20:18-21, 33-35; 2 Tim. 3:10-17).
- E.** Do not hold it cheap.

III. Jesus sends disciples to do his work.

- A.** Show, preach, cast out demons.
- B.** A task for the Church.
- C.** By now you ought to be teachers.
- D.** Send others to do your work.
- E.** You too will die.
- F.** You must say no in order to say yes.
