## **Application Questions**

These questions are provided for your further study and application of today's sermon. Thoughtfully writing out the answers to these questions will help to drive home the point of today's study. It is also helpful when you are able to discuss your answers with others.

- 1. Read **John 15:12-14**. How does the personal and painful cost of Christ's redemptive love change the way you view the command to love others as he himself loved and sacrificed for others?
- 2. Read **1 John 3:11-18**. Why does the church need to be warned against envy, rivalries, and selfishness? How do these subtly infect a congregation professing to "love one another," but actually engaging in the opposite?
- 3. Read **Philippians 2:3-4**. Give some examples of the way you have failed to live up to this command. What are the rationalizations you are tempted to employ when making excuses as to why you can't live this way?
- 4. Read **Philippians 2:5-11**. How does the way the Father honored the Son's selflessness give you the faith to risk being more purposely forgetful about your personal desires, preferences, and reputation in service to others?
- 5. Read **Hebrews 10:24-25**. What steps can you take to sincerely and creatively give more thought to how you might encourage and spur on others in the church to love God, love others, and battle temptation?
