# **Getting the Word Out**

All true Christians believe what the Bible says when we are told in it that the Gospel must get out in order for people to hear and get saved. Even those who are particularly withdrawn should be able to come out of themselves when faced with the great opportunity to tell someone about the Savior that saved their souls! At the very least we can invite our friends to a setting where they can hear the Word of God and the testimony of the saints. Suggestions?: Here's a few - Worship, Sunday School, Bible Study, Youth Groups – all great opportunities for people who need to hear the Word of God to hear it! This is not to let anyone off the hook. I encourage you to pray for opportunities to share the Gospel and for the boldness to actually do it. May our Great God use me and you to broadcast His amazing grace in the Lord Jesus Christ to a lost and desperate world ... even when it is right next door.
