

Revelation is a Revealing or Unveiling of:

- The PersonThe Power, and
- The Program of God
- The last book of the Bible is pre-eminently the Book of the Kingdom of God in <u>conflict with</u>, and <u>victory over</u>, the kingdoms of this world.
- The Person of Jesus Christ (Rev 1:1)
 - ► Same Person born on the earth at His first coming
 - He is the Son of Man, possessing a full human nature
 He will always be human

 - Jesus is also fully divine and will always be that; one with the Father
 Jesus reveals God fully

 - He will share the throne universally with the Father ultimately
 Jesus is the eternal God

Revelation is an Unveiling

- The Power of Jesus Christ
 - He has personal power
 - He has inherent power
 - He wields power Himself
 - ► He has acquired power from the Father
 - He exercises all the power of the godhead
 - He has power over all things, including material forces and objects
 - He controls the physical universe
 - He has power over all angels, demons and Satan; spiritual entities and authorities He has the power to accomplish anything He desires


Revelation is an Unveiling

- ▶ The Program of Jesus Christ
 - To defeat and destroy Satan and sin
 - ▶ To purify for Himself a people who will be a kingdom and priests to God To pour out wrath on His enemies for their refusal to receive His grace

 - To dwell among His people and experience intimate fellowship with them



- Very important event, accompanied by 30 minutes of silence in heaven
- Purpose of the silence: to prepare for what is about to happen through heightened expectation; the lull before the storm
 The 7th Seal opens, revealing the coming 7 Trumpet judgments
- The 7th Seal includes all events from Revelation 8:1-19:10
- John sees seven trumpets being given to seven angels before the throne
- The trumpets are used to announce God's work
- > These trumpets play a major role in God's dealing with His people
- An angel offered incense on the coals before God (v 5), then throws it on the earth
- Result is thunder, rumblings, flashes of lightning and an earthquake

Revelation 8:6-7 Second Trumpet

- God has sent judgment to the earth with the opening of 1st Trumpet
- ▶ The 2nd Trumpet is like a huge mountain, all ablaze, thrown into the sea
- The result is a third of the oceans becoming blood (either "like" blood or actual blood)
- 1/3 of the creatures in the sea died
- 1/3 of the ships on the sea perished
- As of January 1981 there were 24,867 merchant ships registered
- Imagine if 8,289 of them were suddenly destroyed and their cargoes

Revelation 8:10-11 Third Trumpet

- Next a great star (meteor? comet?) falls from heaven onto fresh water sources
- This meteor poisons 1/3 of rivers and streams
- The star is named "Wormwood" and means "bitter" (Deut 29:18)
 - So named for a bitter herb that was fatal to some people and is used as a symbol of divine punishment (Jer 3:15; Jer 9:15; Jer 23:15; Lam 3:15, etc)
 - This judgment is similar to the bitter water God gave the rebellious Israelites to drink in the wilderness (Ex 15:23-25)

 - Also similar to first Egyptian plague (Ex 7:21)

Revelation 8:12 Fourth Trumpet

- Darkness is connected with fourth trumpet
- The light decreases by 1/3
- It seems God reduces intensity of light from sun, moon and stars
- Possibly a partial eclipse or pollution is in view here
- The reduction of light and temperature would have a devastating effect on the earth

Revelation 8:13 Warning

- Announcement of 3 "Woes" warned of coming judgments
- Announcement of 3 woes warned of coming judgments
 Eagles are also mentioned in 4:7 and 12:14
 Could be a literal eagle or an angel
 Triple woe announces an even worse calamity
 The judgment is partially in response to the prayers of the Tribulation saints (6:10)
