IV. The Father's Third Lesson

- A. Child Rearing and the Promises of God
 - 1. Honor Ex 20:12; De 5:16; Mt 15:4; 19:19; Mr 7:10; 10:19; Lu 18:20; Eph 6:2
 - a. *timao* to prize, fix a valuation upon; to revere:--honor, value.
 - b. The Father's Calling
 - i. do not forget my law,

ii. But let your heart keep my commands; - *natsar* - to guard, (to protect, maintain, obey), observe, preserve(-r).

- 2. The first commandment with promise:
 - a. For length of days and long life Ex 20:12; De 5:16;
 - b. And peace they will add to you. Ps 119:165

B. Mercy and Truth - Pr 16:6

1. Characteristics of God

a. *checed* - kindness; piety: reproof, beauty:--favor, good deed(-liness, -ness),

kindly, (loving-)kindness, merciful (kindness), mercy, pity, reproach.

i. Grace and truth came by Jesus Christ - Jo 1:17

- ii. The Law was truth,
 - but w/o grace
 - b/c of the lovingkindness of God, Christ came

b. *'emeth* - stability; certainty, truth, trustworthiness:--assured(-ly), establishment, faithful, right, sure, true (-ly, -th), verity. - Eph 4:15

i. lovingkindness commends truth

ii. A judgmental spirit will deter the reception of truth

2. Association with those Characteristics - Let not, Forsake

a. Bind - *qashar* - to tie, physically (gird, confine, compact) or mentally (in love): --bind (up), join together, knit.

b. Write upon the heart

i. *kathab* - to grave, to write (describe, inscribe, prescribe, subscribe):-- describe, record, prescribe, subscribe, write(-ing, -ten).

ii. Becoming part of the center of your being

- negative Jer 17:1
- positive 2 Co 3:3

3. The Result

a. favor and high esteem

i. *chen* - graciousness, (kindness, favor) (beauty):--favor, grace(-ious), pleasant, precious.

ii. *sekel* - intelligence; success, discretion, knowledge, policy, prudence, sense, understanding, wisdom, wise.

b. In the sight of God and man. - Lu 2:52; Ac 2:47; Ro 14:18

C. True Happiness and God's Direction

1. Trust in the Lord - *batach* - to hire for refuge, to trust, be confident or sure:--be bold (confident, secure, sure), careless, put confidence, (make to) hope, (put, make to) trust.

a. Includes - Mt 6:22

i. And lean not on your own understanding; - Jer 10:23

ii. In all your ways acknowledge Him, - 1Ch 28:9; Ps 37:3,5; Jer 9:23

iii. Do not be wise in your own eyes; - Ro 12:16

iv. Fear the LORD and depart from evil. - 2 Ti 2:19

b. The Results

i. And He shall direct your paths.

ii. It will be health to your flesh,

iii. And strength to your bones.

2. Honor the LORD - Mt 6:33

a. Acknowledgment of Ownership - Le 25:23

i. with your possessions

ii. with the firstfruits of all your increase - Ex 22:29; 23:19; 34:26; De

26:2; Mal 3:10; Lu 14:13

b. The Results - De 28:8

i. So your barns will be filled with plenty,

ii. And your vats will overflow with new wine.
