²⁷ for truly in this city there were gathered together against your <u>u</u>holy servant Jesus, <u>w</u>whom you anointed, both <u>w</u>Herod and <u>x</u>Pontius Pilate, along <u>w</u>with the Gentiles and <u>z</u> the peoples of Israel, ²⁸ ato do whatever your hand and <u>b</u>your plan had predestined to take place. ²⁹ And now, Lord, <u>c</u>look upon their threats and grant to your servants to co ntinue to speak your word with all <u>d</u>boldness, ³⁰ while <u>e</u>you stretch out your hand to h eal, and signs and wonders are performed <u>f</u>through the name of your <u>a</u>holy servant Je sus." ³¹ And when they had prayed, <u>b</u>the place in which they were gathered together w as shaken, and <u>i</u>they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and <u>i</u>continued to speak the w ord of God with boldness.
