Figure 1: Chronology of the Writing Prophets

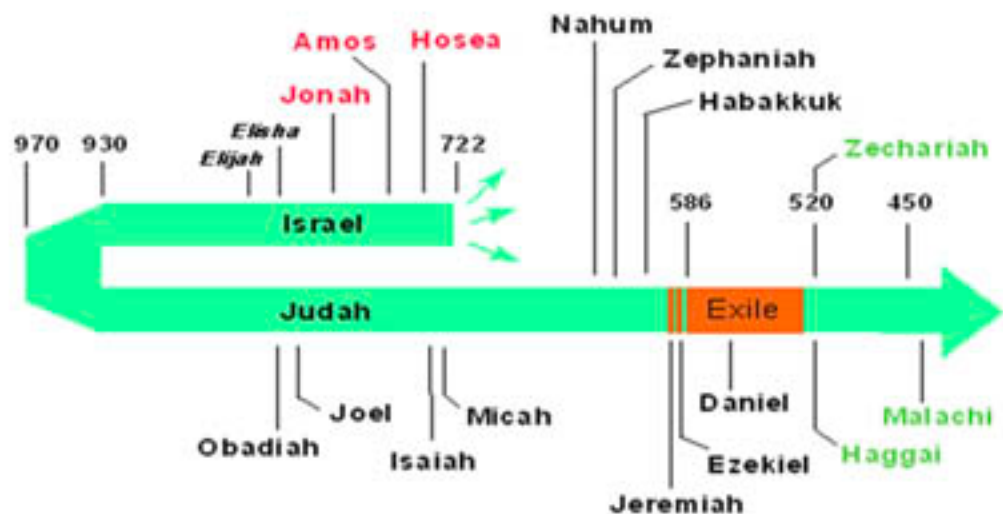


Figure 1: Chronology of the Writing Prophets
