Leader: Which is the sixth commandment?

People: The sixth commandment is, Thou shalt not kill.

Leader: What is required in the sixth commandment?

People: The sixth commandment requires all lawful endeavors to preserve our own life, and the life of others.

Leader: What is forbidden in the sixth commandment?

People: The sixth commandment forbids the taking away of our own life, or the life of our neighbor, unjustly, or whatsoever tends thereunto. (Shorter Catechism 67-69)

Corporate Confession of Sin

Leader: Be gracious to us, O God, according to your lovingkindness; according to the greatness of your compassion blot out our transgressions.

People: Wash us thoroughly from our iniquity, and cleanse us from our sin.

Leader: For we know our transgressions, and our sin is ever before us.

People: Against you, you only, have we sinned, and done what is evil in your sight.

All: For your sake, and your sake only, pardon us from our sins of hatred, and from any and all actions we have taken to kill the reputation and honor of our neighbor.
