

A Greeting of Grace and Glory: Grace to You and Glory to Christ

Revelation 1:4-6

- I. We may expect grace from God (1:4-5a). God intends to strengthen and settle his servants.
 - A. God has a message intended for his servants (1:4a). John wrote to the seven churches of Asia.
 - B. God has unfailing grace for his servants (1:4b-5a). This grace is from the triune God.

- II. We must ascribe glory to Christ (1:5b-6). God intends for his servants to glorify the Son.
 - A. Jesus Christ is worthy of glory (1:5b-6a). He is qualified by his deeds for us.
 - B. Glorifying him must be our Amen through the ages (1:6b). This response is due to him.
