## “Ancestry.Bible” Genesis 5

### Prel Rmks

**(1)** This is the book of the genealogy of Adam. In the day that God created man, He made him in the likeness of God. **(2)** He created them male and female, and blessed them and called them Mankind in the day they were created. **(3)** And Adam lived one hundred and thirty years, and begot a *son* in his own likeness, after his image, and named him Seth. **(4)** After he begot Seth, the days of Adam were eight hundred years; and he had sons and daughters. **(5)** So all the days that Adam lived were nine hundred and thirty years; and he died. **(6)** Seth lived one hundred and five years, and begot Enosh. **(7)** After he begot Enosh, Seth lived eight hundred and seven years, and had sons and daughters. **(8)** So all the days of Seth were nine hundred and twelve years; and he died. **(9)** Enosh lived ninety years, and begot Cainan. **(10)** After he begot Cainan, Enosh lived eight hundred and fifteen years, and had sons and daughters. **(11)** So all the days of Enosh were nine hundred and five years; and he died. **(12)** Cainan lived seventy years, and begot Mahalalel. **(13)** After he begot Mahalalel, Cainan lived eight hundred and forty years, and had sons and daughters. **(14)** So all the days of Cainan were nine hundred and ten years; and he died. **(15)** Mahalalel lived sixty-five years, and begot Jared. **(16)** After he begot Jared, Mahalalel lived eight hundred and thirty years, and had sons and daughters. **(17)** So all the days of Mahalalel were eight hundred and ninety-five years; and he died. **(18)** Jared lived one hundred and sixty-two years, and begot Enoch. **(19)** After he begot Enoch, Jared lived eight hundred years, and had sons and daughters. **(20)** So all the days of Jared were nine hundred and sixty-two years; and he died. **(21)** Enoch lived sixty-five years, and begot Methuselah. **(22)** After he begot Methuselah, Enoch walked with God three hundred years, and had sons and daughters. **(23)** So all the days of Enoch were three hundred and sixty-five years. **(24)** And Enoch walked with God; and he *was* not, for God took him. **(25)** Methuselah lived one hundred and eighty-seven years, and begot Lamech. **(26)** After he begot Lamech, Methuselah lived seven hundred and eighty-two years, and had sons and daughters. **(27)** So all the days of Methuselah were nine hundred and sixty-nine years; and he died. **(28)** Lamech lived one hundred and eighty-two years, and had a son. **(29)** And he called his name Noah, saying, "This *one* will comfort us concerning our work and the toil of our hands, because of the ground which the LORD has cursed." **(30)** After he begot Noah, Lamech lived five hundred and ninety-five years, and had sons and daughters. **(31)** So all the days of Lamech were seven hundred and seventy-seven years; and he died. **(32)** And Noah was five hundred years old, and Noah begot Shem, Ham, and Japheth.

  - 1800 = 1 billion Today = 8 billion 225 years
  - 1056 years until Noah
  - Mankind had begun to spread out over the earth
- 6) To show the chosen Godly line through which the Messiah and Savior would come. ~ The ungodly line of Cain in chapter 4 ...

**Luke 3:23** Now Jesus Himself began *His ministry* at about thirty years of age, being (as was supposed) *the son of Joseph, the son of Heli,*

**Luke 3:36b-38** ... *the son of Shem, the son of Noah, the son of Lamech, (37) the son of Methuselah, the son of Enoch, the son of Jared, the son of Mahalalel, the son of Cainan, (38) the son of Enosh, the son of Seth, the son of Adam, the son of God.*

**(1)** This is **the book of the genealogy\*** of Adam. In **the day that God created man**, He made him in the likeness of God. **(2)** He created them **male and female**, and blessed them and called them **Mankind KJV – Adam; in the day they were created.**

- **the book of the genealogy** – written historical historical record (shows the intelligence of early man), generations
  - Heavens and earth 2:4 ~ Adam ~ Noah ~ Sons of Noah ~ Terah ~ Ishmael ~ Isaac ~ Esau ~ Jacob

**Alternative explanations for length of life stated in this genealogy:**

- 1) It is not a tight genealogy – other offspring between the father and the named son **Jude 1:14** ... Enoch, the 7<sup>th</sup> from Adam
- 2) Years = months Enoch v. 21 65 months 5½ years old when he fathered Methuselah ...

**(3)** And **Adam** lived one hundred and thirty years, and begot a son **in his own likeness, after his image**, and named him Seth.

- **Genesis 1:27** So God created man **in His own image\***; in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them.
    - capable of personal relationship
    - personhood or personality
    - soul – mind, emotion, will
    - untainted – morally upright, good
    - not God – but capable of an unhindered relationship and fellowship with God (walked with God in the garden)
    - still in the image of God, but marred {train wreck}
    - the sin nature and sinfulness of man marred every part of his being – mind, emotions, will (total depravity)
  - **Genesis 5:3** And Adam lived one hundred and thirty years, and begot a son **in his own likeness, after his image**, and named him Seth.
    - {Cole – looked like me}
  - **Psalms 14:1-3 To the Chief Musician. A Psalm of David.** The fool has said in his heart, "*There is no God.*" They are corrupt, They have done abominable works, There is none who does good.
 

**(2)** The LORD looks down from heaven upon the children of men, To see if there are any who understand, who seek God. **(3)** They have all turned aside, They have together become corrupt; *There is none who does good, No, not one.*
  - **Psalms 58:3** The wicked are estranged from the womb; They go astray as soon as they are born, speaking lies.
  - **Ecclesiastes 7:20** For *there is not a just man on earth who does good And does not sin.*
  - **Isaiah 64:6** But we are all like an unclean *thing*, And all our righteousnesses *are* like filthy rags; We all fade as a leaf, And our iniquities, like the wind, Have taken us away.
  - **Isaiah 53:6** All we like sheep have gone astray; We have turned, every one, to his own way; And the LORD has laid on Him the iniquity of us all.
- (4)** After he begot Seth, the days of Adam were eight hundred years; and he had sons and daughters. **(5)** So all the days that Adam lived were nine hundred and thirty years; **and he died\***. ~ 8 other times in this chapter
- **Hebrews 9:27** And as it is appointed for men to die once, but after this the judgment,

- **Romans 6:23** For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

**(6) Seth** lived one hundred and five years, and begot Enosh. **(7)** After he begot Enosh, Seth lived eight hundred and seven years, and had sons and daughters.

**(8)** So all the days of Seth were nine hundred and twelve years; and he died.

**(9) Enosh** lived ninety years, and begot Cainan.

**(10)** After he begot Cainan, Enosh lived eight hundred and fifteen years, and had sons and daughters. **(11)** So all the days of Enosh were nine hundred and five years; and he died.

**(12) Cainan** lived seventy years, and begot Mahalalel. **(13)** After he begot Mahalalel, Cainan lived eight hundred and forty years, and had sons and daughters.

**(14)** So all the days of Cainan were nine hundred and ten years; and he died.

**(15) Mahalalel** lived sixty-five years, and begot Jared.

**(16)** After he begot Jared, Mahalalel lived eight hundred and thirty years, and had sons and daughters. **(17)** So all the days of Mahalalel were eight hundred and ninety-five years; and he died.

**(18) Jared** lived one hundred and sixty-two years, and begot Enoch.

**(19)** After he begot Enoch, Jared lived eight hundred years, and had sons and daughters. **(20)** So all the days of Jared were nine hundred and sixty-two years; and he died.

**(21) Enoch** lived sixty-five years, and begot Methuselah.

**(22)** After he begot Methuselah, **Enoch walked with God three hundred years\***, and had sons and daughters. **(23)** So all the days of Enoch were three hundred and sixty-five years. **(24)** And Enoch walked with God; and he *was* not, for **God took him\***.

The Bible gives commentary on the life of Enoch in two places:

**Hebrews 11:5-6** By faith Enoch was taken away so that he did not see death, "AND WAS NOT FOUND, BECAUSE GOD HAD TAKEN HIM"; for before he was taken **he had this testimony**, that **he pleased God**.

**(6)** But without faith *it is impossible to please Him*, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and *that* He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.

- He did not die. He was raptured – caught up to God. {Elijah – whirlwind}.
- He walked with God by faith and not by sight ...
  - Others – “lived”
  - Enoch was as close to God as any living man has ever been.

- **Jude 1:14-15 [He was a preacher]** Now Enoch, the seventh from Adam, prophesied about **these men** also, saying, **[What was his message]** "Behold, the Lord comes with ten thousands of His saints, **(15)** to execute judgment on all, to convict **all who are ungodly** among them of **all their ungodly deeds** which they have committed **in an ungodly way**, and of **all the harsh things which ungodly sinners have spoken against Him.**"

**(25) Methuselah** lived one hundred and eighty-seven years, and begot Lamech. **(26)** After he begot Lamech, Methuselah lived seven hundred and eighty-two years, and had sons and daughters. **(27)** So all the days of Methuselah were **nine hundred and sixty-nine years**; and he died.

**(28) Lamech** lived one hundred and eighty-two years, and had a son. **(29)** And he called his name **Noah\***, saying, **"This one will comfort us concerning our work and the toil painful toil of our hands, because of the ground which the LORD has cursed."** \*

- Noah = rest
- How would Noah bring comfort and rest concerning the work and painful toil of mankind? 2 main ways:
  - The life and ministry of Noah would bring temporary rest and comfort to the earth from all the sin and strife and violence that was so prevalent by Lamech's day and which made life so much harder on everyone.
  - The main way = Through the line of Noah, the Messiah, the Savior, would come into the world – the One who would crush the head of the serpent, reverse the curse, and open the way back into paradise! That will be a permanent rest!!

**(30)** After he begot Noah, Lamech lived five hundred and ninety-five years, and had sons and daughters. **(31)** So all the days of Lamech were seven hundred and seventy-seven years; and he died.

**(32) And Noah** was five hundred years old, and Noah begot **Shem, Ham, and Japheth.**

- **Genesis 10:21** And *children* were born also to Shem, the father of all the children of Eber, the brother of **Japheth the elder.**
- **Genesis 9:24** So Noah awoke from his wine, and knew what **his younger son [Ham]** had done to him.
- **Genesis 9:26-27** And he said: "**Blessed be the LORD, The God of Shem,** And may Canaan be his servant. **(27)** May God enlarge Japheth, And may he dwell in the tents of Shem; And may Canaan be his servant."

- Shem = semites = Jews = our word "antisemitic"

## Conclusion

### Enoch

1. Are you walking with God, or are you just living – marking time?
2. If we know God through His Son, the LJC, and if we walk with Him, then the day will come when we will step off this earth and we won't be found here, because we will be there – with the One we have walked with in our lifetime.

**John 11:26** And whoever lives and believes in Me shall never die. Do you believe this?
