## Evening Worship September 11, 2016 "People God will Treasure" Exodus 19:1-9

I. Up to God / near God —
And Moses went up to God, ... (Exodus 19:3A NKJ)

...and brought you to Myself. (Exodus 19:4B NKJ)

- 1. The words "up to God" in beginning of Exodus19:3 imply that Moses climbed the mountain.
- 2. The words "brought you to Myself" Exodus 19: 4, spoken by God to Israel, meant that the people were in the vicinity of God's presence.
- A. However, we know He was with them even before this time; He fought for them against the Egyptians –

"The LORD will fight for you, and you shall hold your peace." (Exodus 14:14 NKJ)

And the Angel of God, who went before the camp of Israel, moved and went behind them; and the pillar of cloud went from before them and stood behind them. (Exodus 14:19 NKJ)

B. We know too that God is omnipresent, He is everywhere — Where can I go from Your Spirit? Or where can I flee from Your presence? If I ascend into heaven, You are there; If I make my bed in hell, behold, You are there. If I take the wings of the morning, And dwell in the uttermost parts of the sea, 10 Even there Your hand shall lead me, And Your right hand shall hold me. (Psalm 139:7-10 NKJ)

So, while Moses really did climb a mountain, and there met with God, His symbolic presence, God's presence surely was not limited to that mountain –

"Our fathers worshiped on this mountain, and you *Jews* say that in Jerusalem is the place where one ought to worship." <sup>21</sup> Jesus said to her, "Woman, believe Me, the hour is coming when you will neither on this mountain, nor in Jerusalem, worship the Father. <sup>22</sup> "You worship what you do not know; we know what we worship, for salvation is of the Jews. <sup>23</sup> "But the hour is coming, and now is, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth; for the Father is seeking such to worship Him. <sup>24</sup> "God *is* Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth." (John 4:20-24 NKJ)

3. We climb to God spiritually, we find Him by seeking Him with our heart –

And you will seek Me and find *Me*, when you search for Me with all your **heart**. (Jeremiah 29:13 NKJ)

- A. We see Israel was doing this in the last chapter And Moses said to his father-in-law, "Because the people come to me to inquire of God. (Exodus 18:15 NKJ)
- B. They were willing to stand in long lines to inquire of God ...and the people stood before Moses from morning until evening. (Exodus 18:13 NKJ)

We climb spiritually when we make efforts against our sin nature to climb toward the holiness of God – **Habakkuk 3:19** 

God of the heights, austere, inspiring, Thy word hath come to me, O let no selfish aims, conspiring, Distract my soul from Thee. Loosen me from things of time; Strengthen me for stedfast climb. The temporal would bind my spirit; Father, be Thou my stay. Show me what flesh cannot inherit, Stored for another day. Be transparent, things of time.

Looking through you, I would climb. Now by Thy grace my spirit chooseth Treasure that shall abide The great Unseen, I know, endureth, My footsteps shall not slide. Not for me the things of time; God of mountains, I will climb. Amy Carmichael

II. How do we get to God?

'You have seen what I did to the Egyptians, and how I bore you on eagles' wings and brought you to Myself. (Exodus 19:4 NKJ)

- 1. What God did to the Egyptians, the Israelites were eye witnesses –
- (1) Waters turned to blood Exodus 7:14-25
- (2) Frogs Exodus 7:26-8:11
- (3) Gnats or Lice Exodus 8:12-15
- (4) Flies Exodus 8:16-28
- (5) Livestock disease Exodus 9:1-7
- (6) Boils Exodus 9:8-12
- (7) Hail and Fire Exodus 9:13-35
- (8) Locusts Exodus 10:1-20

(9) Darkness – Exodus 10:21-29 (10)Death of the First Born – Exodus 11:1-12:3

In addition to the plagues, Israel also saw Egypt's army drown in the Red Sea – Exodus 14-15:21

- 2. Israel was bore on eagle's wings -
- A. Not literally
- B. But this pictures the great speed and power of God:
- (1) Delivered from the chains of Pharaoh (took about a year)
- (2) Brought to God I believe spiritually ...

Sure physically they were brought to a mountain, but victory over the Egyptians and a bit of humbly in the desert, I believe made them more ready than before to receive God's word -

<sup>14</sup> Then he said, "Who made you a prince and a judge over us? (Exodus 2:14 NKJ)

and the people stood before Moses from morning until evening. (Exodus 18:13 NKJ)

"Because the people come to me to inquire of God. (Exodus 18:15 NKJ)

Remember too, the people had cried (prayed) to God -

Now it happened in the process of time that the king of Egypt died. Then the children of Israel groaned because of the bondage, and they cried out; and their cry came up to God because of the bondage. <sup>24</sup> So God heard their groaning, and God remembered His covenant with Abraham, with Isaac, and with Jacob. <sup>25</sup> And God looked upon the children of Israel, and God acknowledged *them*. (Exodus 2:23-25 NKJ)

"God whispers to us in our pleasures, speaks to us in our conscience, but shouts in our pains: It is His megaphone to rouse a deaf world" C.S. Lewis

3. Eagle's wings are spoken of elsewhere in Scripture — But those who wait on the LORD Shall renew their strength; They shall mount up with wings like eagles, They shall run and not be weary, They shall walk and not faint. (Isaiah 40:31 NKJ)

"To Him Who is everywhere, men come, not by travelling, but by loving" Augustine

We love Him because He first loved us. (1 John 4:19 NKJ)

III. How do we become TREASURED by God? -

<sup>5</sup> Now therefore, if you will indeed obey My voice and keep My covenant, then you shall be a special treasure to Me above all people; for all the earth *is* Mine. <sup>6</sup> And you shall be to Me a kingdom of priests and a holy nation.' These *are* the words which you shall speak to the children of Israel."

Keys to holiness:

- 1. Obedience "obey My voice" Exodus 19:5
- 2. Relationship "keep My covenant" Exodus 19:5 B Covenant implies promises and a close relationship with God! What is pictured is not so much a servant / Master relationship, but rather a Husband /wife relationship Ephesians 5:22-32
- 3. A high calling connected to this relationship then you shall be a special treasure to Me above all people; for all the earth is Mine. <sup>6</sup> And you shall be to Me a kingdom of priests and a holy nation.' Exodus 19:5-6
  - A. This means being different than other people –
  - B. This is what we are called to as Christians –

But you are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, His own special people, that you may proclaim the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light; (1 Peter 2:9 NKJ)

See this fits in the context of Christ and His cross, as our Chief Cornerstone and example – **1 Peter 2** 

IV. Moses announcement and the people's response - <sup>7</sup> So Moses came and called for the elders of the people, and laid before them all these words which the LORD commanded him. <sup>8</sup> Then all the people answered together and said, "All that the LORD has spoken we will do." So Moses brought back the words of the people to the LORD. <sup>9</sup> And the LORD said to Moses, "Behold, I come to you in the thick cloud, that the people may hear when I speak with you, and believe you forever." So Moses told the words of the people to the LORD. (Exodus 19:1-9 NKJ)

- 1. All that the LORD has spoken we will do Will they?
- 2. The LORD will come to them again, in a thick cloud; this is His reference to coming when He gives them the Ten Commandments. The rest of chapter 19 speaks of their preparation for this event!
