## John 13:31-38

Here the meaning is to openly render divine character and attributes to. (This type of "glorified" is reserved for \_\_\_\_\_\_ alone.)

    - 2. \_\_\_\_\_\_ for each other as fellow Christ-followers Quotes from Barnes' Notes on the New Testament "Not by a peculiar form of dress or manner of speech not by peculiar austerities and unusual customs, like the Pharisees, the Essenes, or the scribes, but by deep, genuine, and tender affection." "Perhaps, of all the commands of Jesus, the observance of this is that which is least apparent to a surrounding world. It is not so much that they are divided into

different sects, for this may be consistent with love for each other; but it is the lack of deep-felt, genuine love toward Christians even of our own denomination; the absence of genuine self-denial; the pride of rank and wealth; and the fact that professed Christians are often known by anything else rather than by true attachment to those who bear the same name- Christian.
