- 4. illustrations: athlete (1Cor.9:26), professional (Rom.13:6; Acts 6:4; contra Jn.10:12)
- 5. examples: oaths (marriage, membership); resolutions (J.Edwards) (Ps.76:11; Mt.5:33f)

III. DEVOTE YOURSELF! (Acts 2:42)

- A. SET YOUR HEART: MAKE UP YOUR MIND! (Ezra 7:10; Lk.9:51; see Membership Covenant, #4,5)
- **B. MAKE YOUR CHOICES: FILL OUT YOUR PLANNERS!** (see Dt.4:37; what, when, where, how) Introduction: objects of devotion in public & in private (see Acts 2:42,46a & 46b)
 - 1. word: hear in public & read in private (Acts 2:42; 6:4 & Acts 17:11; 2Tm.3:14-16; Ps.78:1f)
 - 2. sacrament: participate in public & prepare in private (1Cor.11:18f & 1Cor.11:27f; Eph.6:4)
 - 3. prayer: with in public & for in private (1Kngs.8:22 & Luke 9:18)
 - 4. fellowship: in public worship & in private life (Acts 2:42 & Acts 2:46; Phil.4:15; Rom.13:10,3f)
 - 5. summary: get equipped & go serve (see Eph.4:12f)

C. REDEEM THE TIME: SEIZE YOUR OPPORTUNITIES! (Eph.5:15f; Ps.90:12)

- 1. public worship every Lord's Day
- 2. private word, prayer, fellowship every week (see church calendars)
- 3. personal & family devotion every day (i.e., word & prayer; many resources in our church library)
- D. FULFILL YOUR PLANS & PERSEVERE IN THEM! (Acts 2:42,46; 1:14; see 1Tm.4:16)

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DISCUSSION QUESTIONS FOR PRIVATE, FAMILY AND SMALL GROUP FELLOWSHIP

- 6. Who are the people in the congregation whom you are most helpful to? How so? Whom should you seek to help; who needs the benefits of God's gifts to you?
- 7. What are the three most important ways that you are served in the congregation?
- 8. What are the three most important ways that you serve in the congregation?
- 9. How are you equipped in the congregation to serve? What equipping do you need to seek?
- 10. Has God called you, or is God calling you, to serve in an office (Elder or Deacon)? If so, how are you equipping yourself for this service?
- 11. What do you plan to do on Sunday nights? Is that the best use of your time and opportunities? Is it the most faithful use of the Lord's Day?
- 12. What do you plan to do on Wednesday nights? Is that the best use of your time and opportunities?
