Partners Together in the Gospel Philippians 1:3-8

Main Point:

You are all partners together in the gospel; commit yourself to care for one another as Christ has cared for you.

- 1. Partners together in the gospel care for one another so that the work of the gospel may continue.
- 2. Care for one another personally and with your time and energy.

3. Care for one another with your material resources.

4. Care for one another consistently through thick and thin.

5. Care for one another by praying for one another.

6. Commit yourself to care for one another as Christ has cared for you.
