## **Choices, Comparisons and Consequences**

Psalm 1:1-6

## I. CHOICES: "blessed is the man who does not" (vv.1-2)

- **A. Negative:** "does not walk, stand, sit" (v.1)
  - 1. Associations: "does not walk in the counsel of the wicked"
  - 2. Beliefs: "nor stand in the path of sinners"
  - 3. Character: "nor sit in the seat of scoffers"
- **B. Positive:** "his delight...he meditates" (v.2)
  - 1. Truth: "his delight is in the law of the LORD"
  - 2. Trust: "he meditates day and night"

## II. <u>COMPARISONS</u>: "like a tree...like chaff" (vv.3-4)

- **A. Life:** "he will be like a tree" (v.3)
- **B. Death:** "The wicked...are like chaff" (v.4)
  - 1. Disobedient: "The wicked are not so"
  - 2. Discarded: "The wicked...are like chaff"

## III. CONSEQUENCES: "wicked will not stand" (vv.5-6)

- A. Result: "not stand in the judgment...assembly" (v.5)
- **B. Reason:** "the LORD knows the way..." (v.6)
  - 1. Relationship: "knows the way of the righteous"
  - 2. Ruin: "the way of the wicked will perish"
