- 3. Summary: Praise Him for His proved *ability* to help (1-7; see Ps.100:3, God; Heb.1:3; 7:16)

### C. SECOND CALL & REASON TO PRAISE (8-13)

- 1. Call: Praise the Good King (8,9a(7); 10,11,12a; see Ex.33:19; 34:6f)
- 2. Reason: goodness revealed in His enduring works of grace & mercy (9b,10a,12a; see 13 w/Dan.4:3,34; 7:13f,27)
- 3. Summary: Praise Him for His proved *willingness* to help (8-13; see Ps.100:5, good; Mk.10:45)

#### D. THIRD CALL & REASON TO PRAISE (14-19)

- 1. Call: Praise the King for His Goodies (15, 18,19b; see 21a,b)
- 2. Reasons (see the Gospels!)
  - a. support to the unstable (14a)
  - b. lifting up for the down cast (14b)
  - c. good things to the waiting (15a)
  - d. food for the hungry (15b)
  - e. abundance for the insatiable (16)
  - f. straight paths for the wandering (17a)
  - g. loyalty to the betrayed (17b)
  - h. acceptance to the rejected (18a)
  - i. gifts to the asking (19; see Lk.11:9f)
  - j. objects: reality, reverence & love (18b,19a,20a)
  - k. fulfillment: Messiah (Lk.4:17f; see Ps.145:13 w/Dan.7:13f,27 & Mt.24:30; 26:64)
- 3. Summary: Praise Him for His many & various examples of help (8-13; see Ps.100:5, good; Lk.7:22)
